

## Bible Reading

Here is the same verse but in the New Living Translation.

*For God so loved the world that He gave His only Son. Whoever puts his trust in God's Son will not be lost but will have life that lasts forever. John 3:16*

Same exact verse. Same meaning. Try different versions to see what speaks to you best. The Bible is still the Word of God, even if it doesn't have all the "thou's" and "thus's".
